

Recycling & Refuse Collections Bank Holiday Changes

Usual collection day	Revised collection day
Good Friday 3 April	Saturday 4 April
Easter Monday 6 April – Friday 10 April	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 11 April
Early May Bank Holiday Monday 4 May – Friday 8 May	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 9 May
Spring Bank Holiday Monday 25 May – Friday 29 May	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 30 May
Summer Bank Holiday Monday 31 August – Friday 4 September	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 5 September

No change to subsequent dates, all collections resume on usual days.

Recycling Centres

There are 16 Recycling Centres and Community Recycling Sites throughout the county where a wide range of household materials can be recycled and other household waste deposited for disposal.

Centres are free to use for household waste, except Crewkerne and Dulverton, which have a £2 entry fee. At all centres, there are charges for hardcore, soil, gas bottles and tyres starting at £3.50.
